

# Notes to Authors

- Papers should be clearly and succinctly written and not normally exceed 20 A4 pages, including tables, graphs, and references and an abstract of up to 200 words. Do not use your name as a running heading or footer. All pages should be numbered. The title, author and institutional affiliation should be presented on a cover sheet, with the following page repeating the title (but omitting the authors' names and affiliations).
- Papers will not be considered if they have already been published or are in the process of being published elsewhere. They will be published only if the data used in the study are fully documented and preferably available to researchers for replication. Details of computations sufficient to allow replication should be supplied. 'Articles' will not normally be published if they are mainly descriptive, or minor variations of existing studies, or of limited interest. Descriptive material of broad interest may be submitted as a 'Snapshot' (details below). Submissions should follow the style of prior issues.
- It is a condition of publication of articles in the *Australian Social Monitor* that copyright in any article published is transferred to the Publisher. Submission of a paper will be taken to imply that the author agrees that copyright for the paper is transferred to the Publisher if and when the article is accepted for publication. The copyright covers the exclusive rights to reproduce and distribute the article, including photographic reproductions, microfilm or any other reproductions of similar nature, and translations. However, the Publisher will freely give permission to authors to reproduce articles, or parts of articles, for scholarly purposes (for instance in volumes of collected works), provided appropriate acknowledgement of the original source is made.
- For submissions to all sections, electronic versions are preferred, if possible in Microsoft Word; tables and values for graphs may be submitted in an accompanying Microsoft Excel file if desired. They should be addressed to the incoming editor, Dr Bruce Headey, on brucewh@unimelb.edu.au. Authors must specify whether a submission is an 'Article' which will then enter the peer-review process, or a 'Snapshot' which is a brief, usually descriptive report subject to purely editorial review. For authors without access to email four copies of manuscripts should be mailed to The Editors, The Australian Social Monitor, Melbourne Institute of Applied Economic and Social Research, The University of Melbourne, Victoria 3010, Australia. For posted manuscripts, two copies are required for submissions to the Snapshots section.
- Sections, figures and tables should be titled and numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals in separate sequences. Mathematical and statistical formulations should be as simple as possible and, if more than one, should be numbered by consecutive Arabic numerals in brackets all italicised at the end of the equation, e.g. [eq. 1]. Lengthy mathematical formulations should be placed in appendices.
- Endnotes should be located at the end of the manuscript and listed by consecutive Arabic numerals. An asterisk should be used for a note attached to the name of the author.
- The style for references should be that used in this issue. They should be listed alphabetically by author after the endnotes. References in the text should be made by providing the author's surname followed by the publication year in parentheses.
- If a paper is accepted for publication authors are requested to provide a copy in electronic format preferably in Word: either on disk or as an attachment to an email. Please name your file with your surname and the date, e.g. 'Smith\_2001\_05\_20.doc'. If supplied on a disk, use 3.5" disks (either Macintosh or MS-DOS format). Papers should preferably be in Word format. Figures will be produced by us in Deltagraph; authors need to supply the data for the graphs either in tables in the Word document or in an Excel file. Titles for figures, notes to figures, and instructions for their construction (labels for axes, type of graph, and shading preferences) should be placed at the end of the manuscript.
